**Re: St. Louis Notre Dame Club Scholarship Program**

Dear College Guidance Counselor:

The Notre Dame Club of St. Louis will again award several four-year scholarships to the University of Notre Dame to St. Louis area high school seniors. In the past few years, almost every student who was admitted to Notre Dame and who had demonstrated financial need, as determined by the University, was awarded scholarship aid by our Club. So, if you know of any students in your high school interested in Notre Dame, we urge you to make this information about our scholarship program available to them.

The Club will grant these scholarships based upon the student's academic and extracurricular record and financial need. **Financial need is a prerequisite.** Financial need will be determined by the University based upon the applicant's completed financial aid forms.

The Club invites and encourages all high school seniors with financial need applying to Notre Dame to apply for its scholarship program. Past experience has shown that scholarship award winners normally rank in the top 20% of their high school graduating class. In addition to class rank and superior academic achievement, past winners have generally participated in extracurricular and community activities, held leadership positions and have worked jobs while in high school. The Club seeks well-rounded individuals who have demonstrated their academic proficiency and leadership in addition to interests outside their high school curricula and a strong desire to attend Notre Dame.

Candidates must apply for admission to the University of Notre Dame and must also file both the Financial Aid Profile and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form with the respective processing agencies by the required deadlines. Please note that students must indicate the University of Notre Dame as a recipient of the information filed on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid and College Scholarship Services Profile forms. The Club anticipates the following schedule for the selection of its scholarship winner(s) this year:

The selection process will involve the following steps. Applications for the scholarship will close on April 2, 2012. In early April, the Club will notify approximately 10-15 finalists of their selection. Each finalist will meet with the Club's scholarship selection committee between approximately April 16 and April 20, 2012 for a personal interview lasting approximately twenty minutes. The Club anticipates that it will award several 4-year scholarships in the range of \$1,000 to \$7,500 per year.

Students should be encouraged to submit letters of recommendation from more than one person and should be thorough in listing their honors, achievements, extracurricular activities and work experience.

We would appreciate your assistance in urging potential candidates to apply for the Club's scholarship. I have enclosed several application forms for your use. If you need more, please simply make additional copies of the blank form. I have also **enclosed posters announcing our scholarship program which can be placed on bulletin boards around the school.** If you have any questions concerning these matters, please call me at (314) 259-2215 during normal business hours.
