How to Apply

1: Get to it!

Plan to attend St Charles Community College in 2012-2013 and meet one of the following:

- 3.0 cumulative GPA on your most recent transcript
- Score of 2700 or higher on the GED Exam
- Score of 23 or higher on the ACT

Complete just one application for consideration for one of the Board of Trustees scholarships:

- Academic
- Need-Based (Complete FAFSA application required)
- Fine Arts (Fine Arts applicants are required to submit additional documentation or complete additional requirements. For information and points of contact, visit www.stchas.edu/scholarships)
- Dan Barklage Honorary Scholarship

Plan ahead! You will need to make your request for a transcript/test results and letter of recommendation several weeks in advance in order to submit all required documents at one time.

This is a separate scholarship application from Foundation scholarships. You will need to submit separate documents. You are also encouraged to apply for Foundation scholarships. Applications can be found online at www.stchas.edu/scholarships

2: Request it!

Request and submit your most recent official transcript. Current SCC students can request transcripts through SCC Connection or by submitting a Transcript Request form to the Cashier's Office.

Not a current SCC student? You will need to contact your most recent school to request an official transcript.

You can also submit copies of your official GED results or ACT score to qualify.

Transcript requests should be sent to the Trustee Scholarship Coordinator.

3: Write it!

Type an essay discussing your college/career goals. One page maximum.

4: Show it!

Secure one letter of recommendation. A letter of recommendation should come from someone who knows you through an academic, professional, or civic relationship.

...Now submit it!

Submit your completed application, essay, transcript/test results, and letter of recommendation to **Enrollment Services by 4:30 p.m. on April 2, 2012.** All application documents should be submitted together at one time.

The Scoop

The Board of Trustees Scholarship Program is designed for students at St. Charles Community College who have demonstrated an academic aptitude. Recent high school and GED graduates, home schooled, and existing St. Charles Community College students are all encouraged to apply.

Scholarship award amount: The Board of Trustees Scholarship Program is a tuition waiver that covers the in-district rate of tuition for up to four total semesters (fall and spring only; summer excluded). Recipients that live out-of-district will need to pay the difference between the in-district and out-of-district rate per credit hour total.

Qualifying Criteria: Plan to attend SCC in 2012-2013 and meet one of the following:

- 3.0 cumulative GPA on your most recent transcript
- Score of 2700 or higher on the GED Exam
- Score of 23 or higher on the ACT

Submitted applications will be considered for the Board of Trustees scholarships in which they are deemed eligible. Applicants may qualify for more than one scholarship, but will only be awarded one Board of Trustees scholarship at SCC. Applicants wishing to be considered for a Fine Arts scholarship (music, journalism, visual arts, and theatre) are required to submit additional documentation or complete additional requirements. Applicants must indicate on the application if they would like to be considered for a Fine Arts scholarship and the area of interest. These applicants are required to secure or make arrangements to meet the additional requirements.

Scholarship awards are based on academic achievement, demonstrated financial need through the FAFSA application for the need-based scholarship, or participation in the fine arts.

The Board of Trustees Scholarship Program waives the cost of tuition for up to 72 credit hours. Courses transferred from other institutions or from previous semesters will be considered in the 72 credit hour limit. Students who have completed 72 credit hours are not eligible for Board of Trustees scholarships.

Students receiving A+ scholarship funds are not eligible to receive this award. Students receiving "outside" awards may or may not be entitled to receive this scholarship depending on restrictions of the other program(s) funding their college's expenses.

Renewing Criteria: The scholarship is automatically renewed for up to three additional semesters (excluding summer terms) if a 2.50 cumulative GPA is achieved and at least 6 credit hours are completed. If a student fails to enroll or complete 6 credit hours or their cumulative GPA drops below a 2.50, the student will forfeit the scholarship. If the student meets the 72 credit hour limit, the scholarship may be reduced or they will no longer be eligible for the award.
