

St. Charles High School Pirate Booster Scholarship Application – 2011

This application has four (4) parts to complete.

- I. Write a one-page essay (typed, double spaced) about your higher education goals and how you intend to serve your community after you graduate from college. **Note:** Community is used in the larger sense meaning whatever community you choose to serve not necessarily the St. Charles community.

This has a value of 20 points.

- II. Complete the form listing your School related extra curricular activities. Use high school years only. Eighth grade and previous years cannot be considered. If you are a transfer student, please list activities at your previous school. They count too!

This has a value of 25 points.

- III. Complete the form listing your Community-related activities. Again, please use high school years only.

This has a value of 20 points.

- IV. This part assesses your academic performance and course load. In addition to a copy of your most recent transcript, list on the form any academic honors you have received during your high school career, i.e., Renaissance, student of the month, honor roll. List these even though they may be listed on your transcripts.

This has a value of 20 points.

Note that the number of points so far adds up to 85 points. You can earn an additional 5 points for turning in a complete, neat application. An additional 1.25 points will be added for each semester you attended SCHS vs. other high schools. The maximum number of points that can be achieved is 100.

Judging will be performed by a panel of outside judges selected from community leaders and people in higher education. They will judge “blind” applications; no one will be identified by name to ensure fairness.

The scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Awards Night held in May. Payment of scholarships will be made directly to the selected student’s college or university, upon contacting Booster Treasurer with name and address of college or university.
